4. MISCELLANEOUS MATTERS The following matters will be discussed and possible action taken by the Public Health & Safety Committee
 - a. County Sheriff's Report
Discussion of the need for a flagman on Hwy 83 (Globe Construction) and not having enough signs. There was also discussion of a woman driving her wheel chair on Davis Drive and Chairman Kressin felt the need to contact her.
 - b. Lower Speed Limit on Oakdale Road- Ordinance Committee

 - c. Lower Speed Limit on Edgewood Avenue – Ordinance Committee

A resident on W250 S7875 Center Drive would like a North & South bound sign showing children at play-also a hidden driveway sign would be helpful. This item will be kept on the agenda and Chairman Kressin will look at the area in question for possible improvements.
 - h. Well Water Contamination- Letter from Mary Jo Grosskreutz
Mary Jo Grosskreutz and Judy Timm have contaminated wells possibly due to the landfill on Edgewood Avenue in Big Bend. They want: A test to find out the extent of plume and to have the well tests moved in an area to find out extent of possible contamination. Nathen Borks of the Department of Parks and Land Use was notified of the contamination problem. Ms. Grosskreutz stated they are forming a citizens group to get action on this problem and attain accountability. A copy of the well testing was sent to Jody Timm. This item will be on future agendas for discussion.
 - i. Speed limit on Center Drive – Letter from Dan Breitzmann
No through street, common to other streets that join Center Drive these are reasons why to lower the speed limit in this area. Discussion as to what steps need to be taken to have this speed limit lowered.
