**A RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH A SCHEDULE OF DEPOSITS
ACCORDING TO SECTION 1-7 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE**

WHEREAS, The Town Board of the Town of Vernon is responsible for the establishment of a Schedule of Deposits according to Section 1.7 of the Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, Section 1-7 states that the amount of the deposit shall be as set forth in resolution adopted by the Town Board and shall include penalty assessment as established under Section 165.87, Wisconsin Statutes, and costs.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Town Board of the Town of Vernon, Waukesha County, Wisconsin, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: The attached Schedule of Deposits is established for use with citations issued under the sections listed and referred to as Exhibit A is hereby adopted.

SECTION 2: SEVERABILITY.

The several sections of this resolution are declared to be severable. If any section or portion thereof shall be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, unlawful or unenforceable, such decision shall apply only to the specific section or portion thereof directly specified in the decision, and shall not affect the validity of any other provisions, sections or portions thereof of the resolution. The remainder of the resolution shall remain in full force and effect. Any other resolutions whose terms are in conflict with the provisions of this resolution are hereby repealed as to those terms that conflict.

SECTION 3: EFFECTIVE DATE.

This resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage and posting or publication as provided by law.
