Driveway Installation Guidelines

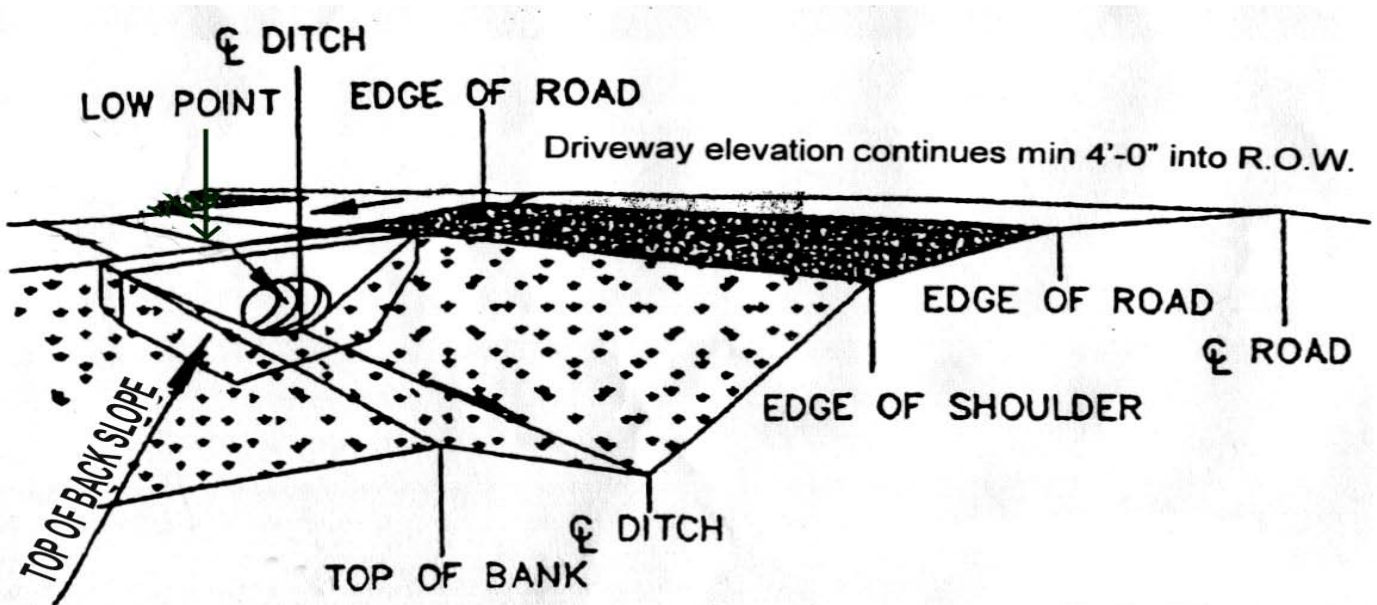
Hard Surface Driveways

All Driveway hard surfaces must connect with the street pavement in a neat, workman like manner. The intersection point of the existing Roadway and the newly constructed driveway hard surface must be even and level.

All hard surface driveways must be constructed and pitched in such a way as to control water flow and to distribute said water to a designated area such as a right-of-way water disperse ditch or a curb and gutter designed for water RUN-OFF. At No Time can the Construction of the hard surface driveway and its ditch cause a negative affect on either the existing roadway or the Town RIGHT-OF-WAY.

The property owner must assume all responsibility for any injury or damage to persons or property resulting directly or indirectly from construction or repair of all driveway entrances or approaches located in the Town Right-Of-Way.

If a driveway or culvert is installed incorrectly than it will be the property owners obligation to correct the problem and to pay any expenses that may occur.
