Significant Calls of Interest

- ➤ 05/1/18-#18-0219 Change of Quarters- Vernon was requested by Western Lakes Fire District for one engine to stand by at their fire station in Dousman to cover calls in their district for the structure in the district. The request was made as part of MABAS box on the first alarm.
- ➤ 05/08/18-#18-0232 Fire Alarm- Vernon fire was dispatched for an automatic fire alarm at Big Bend Elementary school. 1201, 1263, 1292 responded, upon arrival crews found the school being evacuated, and nothing showing from the exterior. 1263 performed an interior investigation and found a smoke detector was activated by an aerosol spray, with no other issues.
- ➤ 05/08/18-#18-0233- Brush Fire- Vernon fire was dispatched for a brush fire. Upon arrival crew found a resident burning brush in their back yard out side of the burning regulations. Crew responded with 1281 and extinguished the fire with water and brooms. Home owners was in procession of a burn permit, but crew explained the regulation to the resident.
- > 05/09/18- #18-0235- Gas Leak- Vernon fire was dispatched for a possible propane leak. 1263 and 1276 responded, upon arrival crews saw nothing from the exterior. During an interior investigation crews found a reading of gas in the basement. Crews vented the residence and was able to get the reading of gas to zero. Crews attempted to reproduce the situation to narrow a cause but was un able to do so. Crews returned back to the residence at a later time to see if the gas built up over time but had no readings during the return visit.
- ➤ 05/13/18-#18-0241- Structure Fire- Vernon was requested by Wales/Genesee Fire Department on MABAS box 37-32 for one tender to respond direct to the incident of a structure fire. 1292 responded and assisted with shuttle water to the fire ground.
- > 05/24/18-#18-0258- Structure Fire- Vernon was requested by Mukwonago Fire Department for one engine for a possible structure fire. 1263 and 1210 responded, while responding Mukwonago upgraded to MABAS box 34-11 to the second alarm. 1263 arrived on scene and assisted with fire attack, and 1210 was assisted with operations. Vernon then assisted with overhaul and then released by command.
